<p>Stairs to move from the Lancashire Fusilier Gallery to the Royal Regiment of Fusiliers Gallery and up to the Quartermasters store</p>	<p>Slip, fall, injury.</p> <p>Risk to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children • Teachers/Helpers • Museum Staff 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Handrails on the stairs • Lift for people with mobility issues. • Introductory talk to group re: behaviour, procedure etc.

Drawers (with artefacts in) to pull out in various locations in the ground floor gallery.	Could trap fingers or walk into a drawer. Risk to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children • Teachers/Helpers • Museum Staff 	Children will be warned to be careful with exhibits and displays. Children will be well supervised by school staff.
Glass doors at various locations within the building.	Risk to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children • Teachers/Helpers • Museum Staff 	All glass within the Museum is safety glass to British Standards. Children are encouraged not to run indoors by venue staff.
Glass cases in various locations around the Museum.	Risk to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children • Teachers/Helpers • Museum Staff 	All glass within the Museum is safety glass to British Standards. Children are encouraged not to run indoors by venue staff.
Platform Lift to the Royal Regiment of Fusiliers Gallery- this must not be used in the event of a fire.	Risk to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children • Teachers/Helpers • Museum Staff 	Visitors are encouraged not to allow children to use the Platform lift unaccompanied.
Occasionally exhibits in the Museum may present a hazard due to their nature or the material they are made from.	Risk to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children • Teachers/Helpers • Museum Staff 	These exhibits will be behind ropes or in cases, or have warning signs with them.
